








SPORTSMAN START LINE CREW PROCEDURES 101

-  OFFICIALS and Track Staff ONLY
-  Designated crew members to be behind this marker once the vehicle is in full stage.
-  Once your vehicle crosses the finish line, all crew are to exit promptly to the outside of the lane.
-  At all times crew members must be aware of their surroundings and at any time not to cross in front of any vehicle which is in the burnout water box.

NEXT VEHICLE PROCEDURE

-  Crew Burnout Spotter must have three (3) lines of vision
 1. Driver
 2. Burnout Track Official
 3. Clear sight down the track

“Once the start line is clear, the Burnout Official will alert the Crew Spotter who will notify the driver that it is safe to proceed with the burnout. Where a Crew Burnout Spotter is not available, the Burnout Official will notify the driver directly that it is safe to proceed with the burnout.”

Please Note: All centre-steer vehicles with engines in front of driver are required to have a minimum of one (1) crew member to be utilised as a Crew Burnout Spotter.
